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Nuclear Stress Test Preparation PM Instructions

Please plan to be here for at least 3-4 hours and follow the instructions below.

- **Do not** eat or drink anything (caffeinated or decaffeinated such as <u>soda</u>, <u>coffee</u>, <u>chocolate</u>, or <u>tea</u>) after 8:00 a.m. the day of the test.
- You MAY drink WATER, MILK, and/or JUICE at any time before the test.
- **Do not** smoke after 8:00 a.m. the day of the test.
- If you are diabetic take your diabetic medication the morning of the test unless given otherwise. Please make sure to bring it with you.
- <u>Wear</u> comfortable clothing (non-metal button up shirt) & shoes for walking on the treadmill (please no metal under wire bras or dresses).
- <u>Bring</u> a drink and a snack/lunch with you; you will need to drink water after each tracer administration and will have an opportunity to eat when the techs give you the right of way. Snack examples: sandwich, fruit, crackers, etc.
- Bring a list of your current medications.
- <u>DO NOT</u> take any of the following medications listed below after midnight prior to the day of the exam,
 <u>BUT BRING THEM WITH YOU</u> on the day of your exam and the techs will let you when you can take them.
- You may take all of your other medications besides the ones (if any) that are listed below as regularly scheduled.
- <u>48 HOUR CANCELLATION POLICY:</u> If you need to cancel your exam appointment, it has to be 48 hours prior to the day of your exam.
- NO SHOW POLICY: IF YOU HAVE CONFIRMED FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT AND THEN DO NOT SHOW UP FOR THE EXAM, WE WILL HAVE TO CHARGE YOU \$250.00 FOR THE MEDICINE THAT WAS ORDERED.
